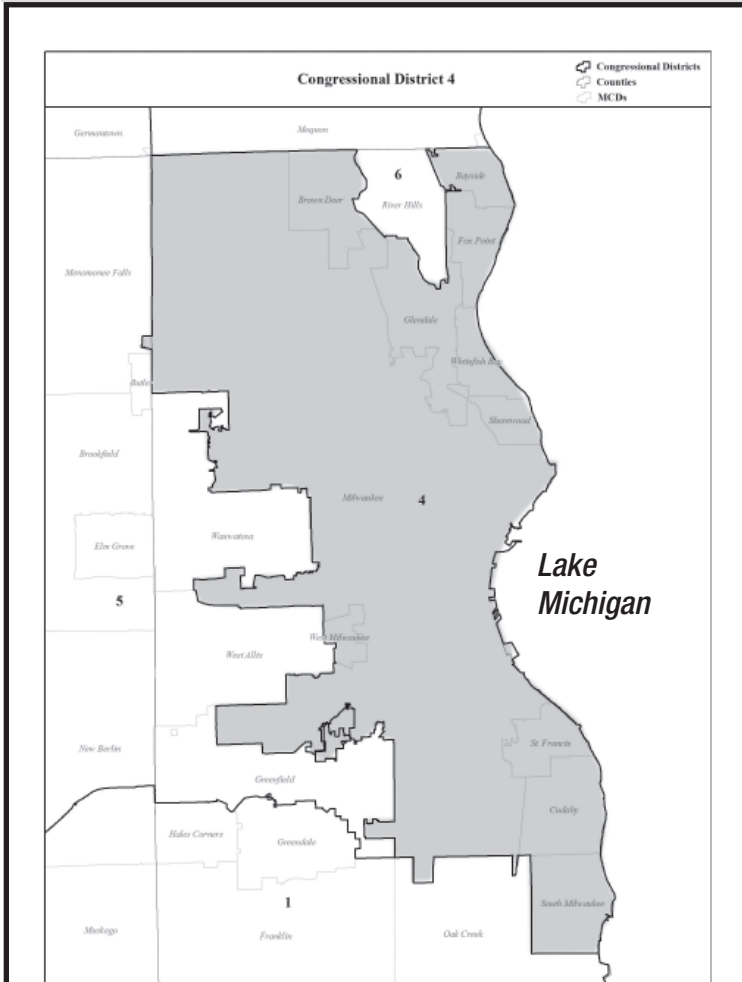

Thank you for your interest in circulating nomination papers for Gwen Moore for U.S. Congress, 4th District. As a circulator, you will be signing a certification that says you personally obtained each signature you are submitting. Read the certification carefully and please follow its requirements.

- Petition circulators must personally witness each signature; this means papers cannot be left unattended for signature collection.
- A person may sign only one nomination paper for a candidate for the Congressional District in an election period. Be sure to ask each person whether he/she has signed another person's nomination paper for the Congressional District, before you accept a signature.
- Please make sure each signer is a 4th Congressional District resident or "a qualified elector". For this race, that means all signers must reside within the 4th Congressional District (municipalities listed above the map).
- You do not need to be registered to vote to sign the petition but rather eligible to register and vote. That generally means 18 years or older, a U.S. Citizen, has lived in the district for at least 10 days, and has not lost the right to vote due to a criminal felony conviction for which the person is currently on probation, parole or extended supervision.
- ALL signatures must be accompanied by a printed name (please don't skip any boxes).
- The signer must indicate his/her residence, including street number. If you live in an apartment, please list your apartment number as well. Make sure signers indicated whether their municipality is a city or village). Post office and rural route numbers are not sufficient. Please check to see that the signer indicates the correct date in the far right-hand box.
- You do not need to fill out all signatures on the page. If you can only get a few, that's fine – send in what you have.
- Complete the certification after circulating the paper, not before. The date of certification should be on or after the latest date of a signer on the page. Please do not sign and date the bottom until after you have finished collecting signatures for the petition.
- Please do not number the pages in the bottom right hand corner; the campaign will enter page numbers.
